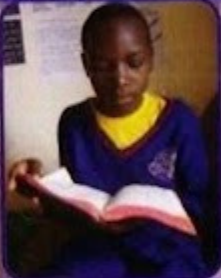

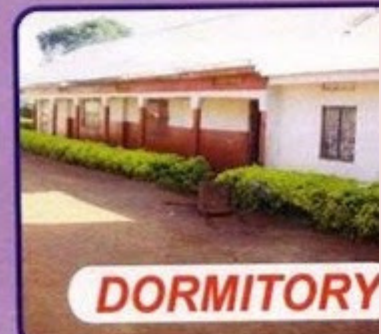

Dr. Kathy is also appreciated for the continued support to Nansamba even if she left school sometime back. Tailoring class is among the Kathy support activities



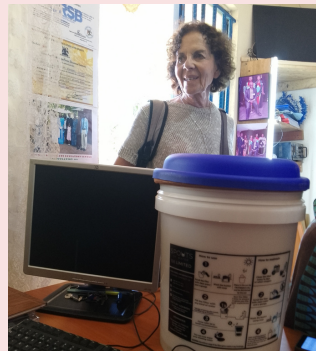
Computer class is a blessing to the children too. Thanks to the Roger family for the warm hands.

CHALLENGES

Year 2024 begun with Challenges which included:

- School Van mechanical breakdown
- Most of children sponsors discontinued
- Effects of COVID remained a big hindrance to school development
- Lack of funds for most of the developmental plans
- Volunteers were not able to come as they used to
- Untimely death of some parents and learners
- hard to get teachers due to national educational change that phased out primary teachers colleges thus requiring teacher to have degrees before they could teach in primary schools, which means the teachers demand high pay to enable them to go for degree upgrading (*in-service*)

SOLUTION

- to acquire new van
- Lobbying for children sponsors
- Recruit parents who can meet tuition for additional funds
- Contacting funding agencies / individuals for support
- Devise means on how and where to get volunteers / internees
- We really have no solution on the death but continued payers
- Finding sponsors to beef up teachers salaries for their degree upgrading
